Our McDowell Place Wii bowlers bowled in the National Senior League Spring Wii Bowling Championships. We had 4 teams to participate and they have had a great time! Teams start the season bowling in conferences made up of 8 teams each. Following 7 weeks of bowling the NSL crowns champions in each conference. Communities receive Certificates of Bowling Excellence for winning conference championships. After conference play the top 32 teams in each of 7 divisions bowl in a one and done format to determine National Champions in each division. National Champions and runner-ups (Finalists) receive NSL Etched Glass Awards. The NSL is in its 11th year of providing Wii Bowling Championships for seniors. On average, they have 75 communities participating each season with 1300+ registered Wii bowlers representing 260 teams. McDowell Place had the ONLY teams from Kentucky in NSL 2021 Spring Wii Bowling Championships.

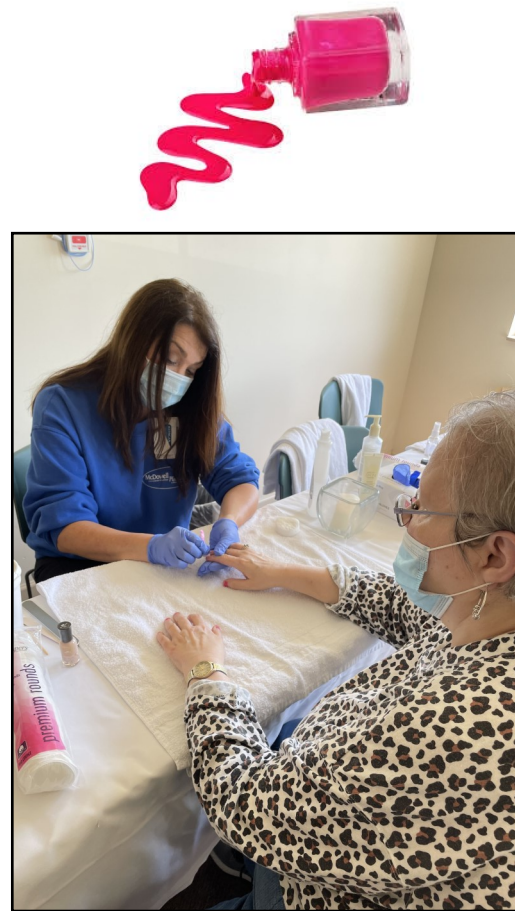

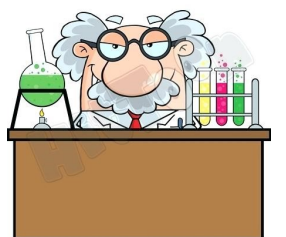
